On February 3, 2020 at approximately 5:31 PM the Brown County Communications Center received a 911 call advising of a two-year-old child that had possibly drowned in a pond at 17220 Malady Rd, Mt Orab, Ohio.

Once on scene deputies made contact with the child's parents who advised that the child had gotten out of the residence while they were sleeping and was located in a pond near the residence. The child was unresponsive and CPR was initiated. Mt Orab Fire and EMS arrived on scene and took over life saving measures until the child was transported to Cincinnati Children's Hospital by UC Air Care.

The child is currently listed in Critical Condition and the names will not be released. No charges have been filed at this time and the investigation is ongoing.
